The Froggies seek to recognise individuals and organisations from all sectors of the community that have made an innovative contribution to creating a sustainable future for the Sunshine Coast and to celebrate their achievements.

Our beautiful Sunshine Coast region is under threat from many different sources: climate change, erosion, pollution from ‘business as usual manufacturing and agriculture’, fragmentation of habitat, urban sprawl and many more.

Fortunately our region is also rich with innovative and concerned people who seek to counter these threats and provide sustainable alternatives in the areas of farming, energy, conservation, fashion and virtually every aspect of our lives. The Froggies seek to honour these individuals and encourage them in their quest to create a more sustainable community.

In previous years, the Froggies have been awarded in categories based on the issues a project sought to address (waste, water etc). This approach did not do justice to the interrelated nature of many of these issues, nor to the ability of many past nominees to respond to multiple issues.

This year the categories have been re-written along organisational rather than environmental boundaries. This year the Froggies seek to recognise a champion in each of the following categories

- Government
- Small/Medium Business
- Large Business
- School
- Not for Profit Association
- Individual

Nominees in each category will be judged on their success in minimising negative impacts on the environment **and maximising positive outcomes** for the environment. Each nominee will be asked to comment on how their initiative contributed to:

- Conservation and restoration of the natural environment
- Reducing fossil fuel dependence and minimising emissions
- Minimising and managing waste
- Minimising the consumption of resources (renewable and non-renewable)
- Educating the community about the importance of their initiative

In recognition of his tireless work for the environment, the SCEC management committee will honour the memory of Mark Ricketts by awarding the; “Mark Ricketts - Pushing the Envelope Award” to a project or initiative that has gone ‘*above and beyond*’ in preserving our environment. The award will be presented at the discretion of the SCEC Management Team to a nomination from any category that the judges consider to be of outstanding quality.
